

## **BPAC Meeting: September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2005**

#1-We spoke about the format for the USADB's 2006 tournament: 16/16 Men's and Women's. We found out that the format are not in the bylaws and that we asked Tom Morrison to make a motion to the USADB's board next week (September 25,2005) to make the format of 16/8 Men's and Women's for St. Louis's tourney.

#2-Spoke about Doug Mader, who is an interim tournament director as some of us did not know if he was on the USADB's board or not but Tom confirmed that Doug Mader is on a trail basis for USADB this year and is not on the USADB's board.

#3-We do not have a Women's Commissioner at this point as Janice Logan resigned.

#4-David Hamilton announced that the DIFB, Deaf International Federation of Basketball would come to USA in June 2006. Two locations were selected, Los Angles and Washington DC (Gallaudet). They are not confirmed thru USADB or USADSF yet but David wants to have 2 locations. (Los Angles and Washington D.C) The location of Los Angles can have 4 regions of basketball teams to compete with the international teams, vice versa with the Washington D.C.'s location with the other 4 regions. Instead of just sending one team that represents USA, USADB can invite the other basketball teams who are interested to play in the DIFB's tournaments.
